**MASTER PLAN - PUBLIC HEARING**

Jim Hicks and Darren Mochrie of RKG Associates appeared before the Board. The public hearing was opened at 7:01 p.m. Mr. Hicks explained that this the final draft of the Master Plan. Ms. Duane asked for public comment; Luigi Bartolomeo stated that he has attended some of the forums and they were handled very well. Mr. Bartolomeo stated that he does not want this to fizzle out and keep the momentum going. Mr. Hicks stated that the Planning Board has discussed conducting a yearly review of the Master Plan.


