## **Petition to Change to Boundaries of the Conway Village Fire District**

The Commissioners of the Conway Village Fire District (CVFD) hereby request the Boards of Selectmen of the Towns of Conway and Albany, NH approve changing the boundaries of the Conway Village Fire District to include the following: That portion of Map 262 Lot 71 that is neither within the Conway Village Fire District nor the North Conway Water Precinct; Map 262 Lot 71.01; Map 252 Lot 60; and that portion of Map 252 Lot 62 that is neither in the North Conway Water Precinct nor the Redstone Fire District.

These lots make up what is commonly referred to as the 'C-9 Non Precinct Fire Area'

There are no residents within this area.


Bringing these lots into the CVFD will make sewer available to them, increasing the development potential and buildability of these lots.


CVFD added a sewer chimney to service portions of this area when it completed the sewer collection system project north of the Saco River.

This is a logical expansion of the CVFD as the CVFD's Fire Department already services this area under the non-precinct fire agreement and the CVFD water and sewer infrastructure was designed to include a portion of it.



Title III. Towns, Cities, Village Districts, and Unincorporated Places (Ch. 31 to 53-F) (Refs & Annos)

Chapter 52. Village Districts (Refs & Annos)

N.H. Rev. Stat. § 52:5

52:5 Changing Boundaries.

Currentness

I. The selectmen of towns in which any such district has been established upon petition, after notice to parties interested and a hearing, may change the boundaries thereof; and the district shall cause the petition and the return of the selectmen's proceedings and decision thereon to be recorded in the records of the district, and of the towns in which it is situated, within 60 days after the decision.

II. In the case of any district formed for the purpose of impoundment of water, any such change of boundaries shall be ratified before taking effect by the voters domiciled in the district and in any area proposed to be added to the district in the same manner as is required for the initial establishment of the district.

III. In the case of any district formed for the purpose of the supply of water for domestic and fire purposes, which may include the protection of sources of supply, any such change of boundaries shall be ratified before taking effect by the voters domiciled in the district and in any area proposed to be added to the district in the same manner as is required for the initial establishment of the district.
