- 1.) State of NH, State Fire Code SAF-C 6000, NFPA 101 Life Safety Code 2015 edition and NFPA 1, 2009 edition. As of August 1st 2016.

Town of Conway
 - 1.) Original Boca (1984) adopted by Town along with NFPA (1981) on March 11th 1986 @ Town Meeting.
 - 2.) Next adoption or updates done on March 12th, 1991 of BOCA 1990 and NFPA of 1988.
 - 3.) Next adoption or updates done on March 12th, 1994 of NFPA 101 Life Safety Codes (most recent addition adopted by the State of New Hampshire Fire Marshal’s Office).
 - 4.) Next adoption or updates done on March 10th, 1998 of BOCA 1990 to 1996.
 - 5.) Next adoption was on April 8, 2003 to authorize the Building inspector to enforce the currently adopted version of the state Building Code. Article 39
 - 6.) The State of N.H. adopted IBC 2000 along with IMC, IPC, IEC and NEC 2002 on September 14, 2002
 - 7.) Manufactured Housing Standards, adopted by the state of NH on December 24th 2005.
 - 8.) IRC (International Residential Code 2000) adopted by the State of NH Senate Bill 234 Effective date July 8, 2006.
 - 9.) State of NH adopted the 2006 versions of the IBC, IRC, IPC, IEC and IMC on August 17th of 2007.
 - 10.) NEC 2008 adopted as part of the state package July 1, 2008
 - 11.) State of NH adopted the 2009 versions of the IBC, IRC, IPC, IEC, IMC and 2011 NEC in April of 2010. (*Amendment to R313 sprinklers shall be in April 2012*)
 - 12.) The State Fire Code updates the Life Safety Code NFPA 101 and Fire Code NFPA 1 to the 2009 editions is now in effect (effective date December 23, 2011).
 - 13.) April of 2012 residential sprinklers are now required in all residential structure (see RSA-A:2 State Building Code)
 - 14.) On June 18, 2012 the IRC was ratified with amendments deleting the requirements under R313.2 for one and two-family dwellings automatic fire sprinkler systems.
 - 15.) On March 14th 2014 the state adopted the IEBC to the state building code.
 - 16.) On January 1, 2015 the State of NH adopted the 2014 version of the NEC with amendments.
