Are you prepared for winter?

- Remove all portable objects from the right-ofway, such as basketball hoops.
- Make sure that your mailbox and post are secure and will not be damaged by heavy, wet snow.
- Do not place grade stakes in the right-of-way.
- Avoid driving during and immediately after a snowstorm.
- If you do have to drive during a snowstorm, drive slowly, brake slowly, and allow extra room between your car and the vehicle in front of you.

Winter Parking and Snow Removal:

- From November 15 to April 1 of each year, no person shall park any motor vehicle on any public highway between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m. or at any other time in such a manner as to impede snow removal operations.
- No person is allowed to put or place snow or ice into the roadway. When shoveling or plowing your driveway, keep the snow on your property.

LOCATION FOR MAIL & NEWSPAPER BOXES

In general, all mail and newspaper boxes are allowed to be installed at the owner's risk within the Town road Right-of-Way lines for purposes of convenience. Claims for damages or other liabilities are not acceptable by the town on the basis of this consent.

The following minimum requirements provide a standard for a uniform policy that will tend to reduce the possibility of damage or liability. Installations should be sufficiently sturdy so as to withstand the weight of heavy snow from plowing operations
