(6-0-2[Mr. Drinkhall and Ms. McCarthy]) 19 20 21 **Update on 2022-2023 CMBC Meeting Schedule:** Vice Chair Jost noted the schedule is in draft form pending the determination of dates for the public 22 23 hearing and deliberative sessions. 24 25 **Old Business:** 26 Mr. Colbath updated the board on the inability to increase/ revenue through rooms and meals tax. Also advising the board of the town's investigation into parking meters within the North Conway 27 village. The police department does not have enough staff, nor are they interested in enforcing the 28 29 parking. There are several part-time employees serving as parking enforcement for Parks and Recreation areas 30 31 32 Mr. Marvel provided an update on the June 13, 2022, School Board meeting public comments 33 pertaining to the Facility Use Committee's proposal. Many of the comments were in opposition to closing a school and the School Board is proposing using a warrant article to let the 34 voters choose. 35 36 37 **New Business:** 38 Mr. Jensen presented the committee with information he has collected to date regarding the 39 elusive amount of money that is collected by Conway through rooms and meals tax. In working with 40 the DRA, to date he has acquired the amount of funds collected by county of which 18% is returned to each town (only 8-9 in Conway). A discussion ensued among the committee regarding what the 41 remaining 82% of the funds are used for and what the next steps will be upon completion of the data 42 43 collection. 44
